



Dr. Seuss' Fun Slime: Oobleck



Simple Supplies:

- 1 cup of Water
- 1-2 cups of Cornstarch
- Food Coloring
- Bowl to mix in

*Tip: If you want to color your Oobleck, it's easier to color the water before you mix it up, than to try and color the mixture afterwards

How - To:

- 1. Pour 1 cup of cornstarch into the bowl
- 2. Pour the water in, mixing slowly as you go.
- 3. Keep adding water until the mixture becomes thick. If it gets too runny, add more cornstarch, if it gets too thick add more water.

Important Clean-up notes:

- Washes up with water. You can use a damp sponge to clean up the mess.
- When it dries it turns back into cornstarch and can be swept up.
- Mix with a lot of water before pouring down the sink.

Fun things to try:

- If you have a large bin, tub, or kiddie pool, make a big batch, take off your shoes and socks and try to stand on Oobleck
- Roll some into a ball. It will become a solid, and melt back into your hand when you stop moving it.
- Put some Oobleck on a cookie sheet and set it on top of a speaker, watch it dance to music!
